

ANNOUNCEMENT STAYTON FIRE DISTRICT RESIDENT VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER

1 POSITION

The purpose of the Resident Volunteer Firefighter program is to enhance the fire and medical responses in the District with trained and available personnel.

This is a 2 year volunteer position that requires the individual to maintain the fire station as his/her principal place of residence. The Resident Volunteer is assigned to a rotating duty shift of 6 PM to 6 AM on weekdays and 6 AM to 6 AM on weekends. The position also requires an additional time commitment of two (2) hours per week in training as well as time required by emergencies. Resident Volunteers respond to the scene of emergencies on Fire District apparatus and receive a point allowance for each drill or call as specified by Policy. The Fire District furnishes the Resident Volunteer with living quarters, lavatory facilities, kitchen facilities, and laundry facilities.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- A resident volunteer shall be in good, sound physical and mental condition.
- A resident volunteer shall be asked to pass a physical agility test, medical examination, and drug screen.
- Must be 18 years of age.
- Must possess a valid Oregon Drivers License.
- Certification of medical training of First Responder of greater is preferred.
- Certified NFPA Firefighter 1 is preferred.

Applications will be available after August 31, 2009 from the Stayton Fire District's Office at 1988 West Ida Street, Stayton.

Completed applications are due to the District Office by 5 PM on September 11, 2009.

Candidates will be interviewed the third week of September.
