



Fuel Reduction Specialist Part-Time Position Announcement

Stayton Fire District is seeking to hire a part-time Fuel Reduction Specialist to oversee our Community Wildfire Risk Reduction Program. The position will be 16 hours/week and may have a variable schedule.

This position will promote defensible space and public education, manage our fuel reduction trailer program, and conduct defensible space home assessments.

The position will start in Fall 2024 and work year-round, which may have limited time during the winter months.

Pay is \$17.00/hr. The position should not exceed 24 hours a week.

Minimum Qualifications

- Must possess and maintain during employment a valid Oregon Driver License
- 18 years of age
- Pass a criminal background and drug screening test
- Capable of operating a vehicle, pulling and backing a trailer

Preferred Qualifications/Traits

- Ability to work with little supervision
- Training on defensible space in the wildland-urban interface
- Ability to communicate with the public
- Customer Service
- Wildland experience and/or knowledge
